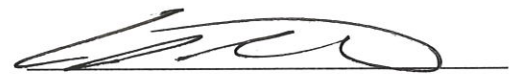

WHEREAS, it is a requirement under the Wisconsin Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (WPDES) permit issued by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) to file a Compliance Maintenance Annual Report (CMAR) for the Village of Bagley Wastewater Treatment/Wastewater Collection System under Wisconsin Administrative NR 208; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to acknowledge that the governing body of the Village of Bagley has reviewed this Compliance Maintenance Annual Report; and

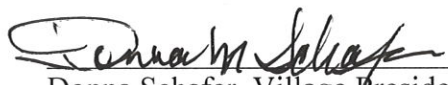

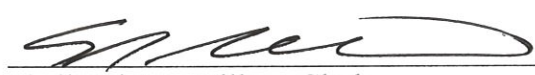

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR USE OF COMMUNITY FACILITIES AND THE VILLAGE PARK IN THE VILLAGE OF BAGLEY, GRANT COUNTY, WISCONSIN.

WHEREAS, the Village of Bagley currently rents out use of the Community Building for a fee and the Village Park at no charge via reservations with the Village Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Bagley has noticed an increase in requests to reserve both the Community Building and the Village Park, but just the Village Park is used resulting in no rental fee; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the Village of Bagley to adopt rates for use of these facilities to aid in covering the costs of maintenance, repairs and improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF BAGLEY, GRANT COUNTY, WISCONSIN:

1. Beginning, January 1st, 2026, the following rates will apply for rental of the Community Building and Village Park:

- a. Community Building: \$15.00 per hour, over four (4) hours will be a day rate of \$100.00
- b. Village Park: \$20.00 for one half of the day, \$40.00 for a full-day~

2. Time for setup and cleanup are included in the rental charge. Example if a reservation is made for 2pm to 4pm but the renter begins setting up at 1:30 pm and finishes cleaning up at 4:30 pm, the renter will be charged for three (3) hours.

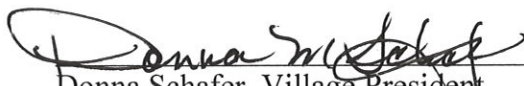
3. In order for an event or activity to be exempt from a rental fee, a Rental Fee Waiver Agreement is required with approval by the Village Board. Village of Bagley departments, groups or committees are exempt. Non-profits from the Village of Bagley are also exempt.

4. Payment is due on the day of the reservation.
